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PLANTING | IL SOYBEAN HISTORY

ILLINOIS SOYBEAN HISTORY


Soybeans were not a popular growing crop in Illinois until the 1920s. Since then, improvements in genetics and machinery have allowed IL farmers to increase their acreage and yield over time. In 1930, IL farmers planted 720,000 acres with an average yield of 17 bushels per acre. Today, IL farmers plant around 10,600,000 acres with an average yield of 64 bushels per acre!

FLORICULTURE

Floriculture is a branch of horticulture focused more specifically on the cultivation of flowering and decorative plants. This includes bedding plants, house plants, flowering garden plants, and cut greens and flowers.







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DAIRY | DAIRY COW NUTRITION

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A 1,500 pound dairy cow eats 100 pounds of feed each day. This includes corn silage, hay, ground corn, soybean meal, and vitamins and minerals. Cows also drink 30-50 gallons of water each day!
